GCSE Maths Resits

As you are aware your child is currently studying to re-sit their GCSE Mathematics exam as they did not achieve a level 4 or grade C. The 4 grade is considered a pass nationally now since the grading system has changed. As a department we have decided that they will sit the foundation paper as we have done some analysis and feel this will give them the best chance possible of achieving their grade in Maths.

They will be sitting their examination at the next opportunity which will be on the 2 November. The school will pay for one re-sit per student so if they do not get the grade in their November examination then we will be asking that cost for the June entry to be covered.

The exam dates are listed below, but so they are prepared for these examinations we ask that they bring the following equipment to every lesson as well as for their exam.

- Scientific Calculator
- Protractor
- Compass
- Pen & Pencil
- Ruler
- Eraser

- Thursday November 2 9:00am Non-Calculator
- Monday November 6 9:00am Scientific Calculator needed.
- Wednesday November 8 9:00am Scientific Calculator needed

To further help your child we will be running revision sessions every Tuesday from 2:40pm-4:00pm in Zone 5 beginning Tuesday 26 September, with a possible Saturday Revision session on Saturday 4 November.
