### November Maths PPE Exams

I am writing to inform you of the Maths PPE Exams that will be taking place in November. The days your child will be sitting these exams are on either Friday 3 November, Monday 6 November and Wednesday 8 November, 2017.

Friday 3 November – Y12 IB Maths Studies examination

Monday 6 November – Y13 IB Maths Studies examination

Wednesday 8 November – Y12 Maths Standard examination

These mock exams will give students, teachers and parents a clear indication of progress towards the final exams. Also with this it is a useful exercise as it allows the maths team to use the data to target more specific intervention and lessons in order to achieve target grades and beyond.

It is vital that the students are entered at the most appropriate course, so depending on the results of the IB Maths Standard paper will determine whether your child continues with this course or whether they switch to the IB Maths Studies. Maths standard is a harder level but both final examinations accrue the same number of university points so students should not be disadvantaged by this change.


Please support us by ensuring your son has the correct equipment that will help make the examination run smoother as well as give him the best chance to succeed. Your son will need the following equipment for these exams:

- Graphic calculator –these are necessary for the exam and cannot be provided by the school
- Scientific Calculator
- Protractor
- Compass
- Pen & Pencil
- Ruler
- Eraser

Of course, we would also expect that he will now make the most of the time remaining in order to improve as much as possible on his grades and make the most of his revision. Revision sessions will begin very soon which will also serve its purpose of preparing your child for their examinations.
