Year 9 Maths & Statistics Exam – Week beginning 24 June 2019

I would like to take this opportunity to inform you that your son will be sitting a Maths & Statistics exam the week beginning Monday 24 June 2019. The maths examination will be a non-calculator and the statistics examination will require them to have a scientific calculator. The day they will sit the exam will correspond with when their first two lessons of maths are in that week.

This examination will give students, teachers and yourselves a clear indication of progress that has been made throughout the year and will help inform the decision of which teaching set your son will be placed in for the start of the next academic year.

It is vital that your son is allocated to the most appropriate set so that students in each class are all working at an appropriate level and making similar progress together; these examinations will help us to make an informed judgement.
