As one of the UK's biggest fundraising events, Sport Relief brings the entire nation together to get active, raise cash and change lives.

There will be a number of events happening throughout the week of 9-13 March. The staff at NTC will be attempting to run, cycle and row around the M25. In the restaurant at breaks and lunch times students will be able to encourage and support the staff as they attempt to complete the 117 miles in 5 days.

Students are able to participate in rock climbing club who will be attempting to ascend the height of Mount Everest at 8850m, by climbing on the rock climbing wall a total of 880 times. There will also be a penalty shoot-out held after school for students to participate in for £1 with a prize for the best result.

It's Game On, on Friday, 13 March when NTC will be hosting a sponsored 1 mile run around our school field. During Period 5 we will make our way to the field ready to start at 2:00pm. When the students have completed their run they will be free to go home. We estimate this will be approximately 2:15pm. Provision will be made for those students who cannot get picked up until 2:40pm in their Community Zones.
